Delhi's air quality was in the "very poor" category on Wednesday morning a day after the air quality index (AQI) jumped to the "severe" zone for the first time this season pushing the national Capital into a pollution emergency.

Rai said that the Delhi Government will run a special drive at the 13 pollution hotspots in Delhi, including Narela, Anand Vihar, Mundka, Dwarka, Punjabi Bagh, among others. "Fire tenders will be deployed at these places to sprinkle water," he said.

"Construction activities have been stopped across Delhi in view of pollution. I have directed Labour Minister, Manish Sisodia, to give Rs 5,000 pm as financial support to each construction worker during this period when construction activities are not permitted," he tweeted.
